Re: The Conflict Minerals Trade Act / Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act

Dear Valued and Concerned Customer:

All materials supplied to and manufactured by Chemtronics are free of materials derived from "conflict minerals", per Section 1502 of the 2010 Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act. This includes gold, tin, tungsten, tantalum, and any of those "conflict minerals" derivatives that originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country (presently includes Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia).

Currently, Chemtronics sells no products that contain gold, tungsten or tantalum. Chemtronics sells only two products that contain tin. From our supplier of tin and their smelter, we have demanded and received documentation certifying that the source of this tin is not from conflict minerals.
